

## **RULES AND REGULATIONS**

### **I. ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS FOR ADMISSION**

(As per the eligibility rules and regulations of Bharathidasan University)

#### **UG. PROGRAMME**

- a) 10, +2 System of examination of all recognized, statutory boards of Higher Secondary examinations.
- b) Indian School Certificate Examination conducted by the Council for Indian School Certificate examination.
- c) Senior school certificate examination conducted by central board of secondary education
- d) Overseas examinations General certificate examination (G.C.E) - Advanced level, passed with atleast three subjects of advanced level and English of Advanced or Ordinary Level.

#### **PG. PROGRAMME**

A Bachelor's Degree in the particular branch to which admissions is sought.

### **II. CLASS HOURS**

Ordinarily a week consists of six working days.

College Timings : 9.30 a.m - 3.30 p.m

Every Monday & Friday, the morning session will commence with prayer presided over by the Principal and Vice Principal . Every period will commence with a short prayer in the classroom.

### **III ATTENDANCE**

Punctuality and regular attendance for class is insisted upon. Attendance at the prayer is compulsory for all the members of the staff and students. Attendance will be taken every hour. Absence of any one hour in a session will be treated as absence for that session.

**IV LEAVE OF ABSENCE:**

1. A student requiring leave for a particular hour or a portion of it has to get permission from the Asst. Professor concerned.
2. Student will not be allowed to absent herself from the college without leave letter, for leave she must apply in advance stating the reasons for her absence.
3. Leave should be applied in the prescribed leave application form duly signed by the class teacher and by the parent/guardian/ hostel warden. The leave letters should be submitted to the HOD.
4. In case a student is absent due to unforeseen causes, she has to give the leave letter on the first day of her return to the college.
5. Continued irregularity will be seriously dealt with
6. Permission will not be granted normally during working hours to meet the parents / guardians / relatives or friends
7. Students must not absent themselves from tests and pre-semester examination as they form the part of C.I.A.
8. Minimum attendance requirement is 75% to write the university exams.

**V DISCIPLINARY REGULATIONS:**

1. The students are expected to conduct themselves in such a manner as not to bring discredit to the college or to themselves.
2. Students should wear clean and decent dress conforming to the rules of modesty
3. The members of the staff are also expected to have regard for conventional dress.

4. The members of the staff are always expected to set the best example for the students in matters of dress, conduct and behaviour.
5. The students are expected to be attentive and silent while attending class, meeting or any other gathering. They are requested to spend their leisure hours in the reading room or library. They should not loiter on the verandahs and disturb classes at work.
6. The cleanliness of the college building & surrounding should be maintained by every student. No student should write or mark on the wall or any part of the college premises or any piece of furniture and throw paper or spill ink on the floor. Any student found doing so is liable to be punished. Every student should keep the class room & college premises, quite neat & clean.
7. Students are expected to read the circulars & notices displayed on the college notice board carefully every day in the morning as soon as they arrive and in the evening before they leave. Ignorance of the circular will not be accepted as an excuse for failing to comply with it.
8. No meeting of any kind shall be held in the college without the previous written permission of the authorities.
9. No students shall take part in political agitations directly against the authority or the Government or engage prominently in any public movement.
10. No notice of any kind shall be circulated among the students or displayed on the notice board without the previous written sanction of the Principal.
11. Private collection of funds must not be made without the approval of authorities.
12. Students are advised not to bring cell phones to the college. Those who are found in possession of cell phone are liable to be punished severely.

**Note : Under the Government's Educational Rules, the Principal has full power to give the following Punishments Fine, loss of attendance, suspension & expulsion.**

### **VI. SCHEME OF CONTINUOUS INTERNAL ASSESSMENT**

Internal evaluation will be done through a continuous process of Internal assessment (C.I.A) as it is mentioned below:

Best 2 tests out of 3 - 15 marks (Retest for genuine absentees)

Group Activity / quiz - 5 marks

Assignment - 5 marks

1. Value Education is offered in the 1st semester in all UG courses ( 2 hours - 2 credits)
2. Environmental studies course is offered in the 2nd semester in all UG Programmes as per the recommendation of UGC ( 2 hours- 2 credits).
3. Soft skills development is offered in the 5th semester in all UG programmes ( 2 hours-2 credits)
4. Extension & Extra curricular Activities should be carried a part from the regular class hours (1 credit)
3. Gender studies is offered in the 6th Semester in all UG Programmes ( 1 hours- 1credit)

### **VII. IDENTITY CARDS:**

Each student of this college is expected to possess an identity card with her photograph affixed on it, duly signed by the Head of the Institution. Students should wear their Identity cards.

### **VIII LABORATORIES:**

The Laboratories are equipped with costly apparatus and appliances. Hence, great care must be taken in handling the equipment. All breakages, damages, losses etc, must be reported to the professor concerned as soon as they occur. The students are liable to pay the breakage charges.

**IX NATIONAL SERVICE SCHEME:**

The national service Scheme (N.S.S) is a programme organized by the Ministry of Education and youth service to afford opportunities and training in service to the community & to the nation, for students with an aptitude.

Each student attending the N.S.S. will be required to put in 120 hours of service activity in each academic year and she will be expected to maintain a diary showing the details of her participation duly countersigned by the programme officer.

Certificate will be issued to the deserving members after the completion of their two year term. Members are expected to participate in all the training programmes and work-camps organized from time to time. The N.S.S. volunteers, who participate in the camps are given 5 marks in addition to the marks they secure in the university exams, while pursuing higher education or attending an interview.

**X RED RIBBON CLUB**

The Red ribbon club programme is a voluntary organization, aimed at heightening the risk -presumption and preventing HIV among youth. The RRCs empowers students in the age group of 17-25, by giving them information and life skills to protect themselves from HIV or AIDS and charges the most active among them into peer educators.

**XI. ROTARACT CLUB**

Rotaract is an international organization of service clubs for men and women aged 18 to 30 that fosters leadership and responsible citizenship, encourages high ethical standards in business and promotes international understanding and peace. Rotaract clubs conducts formal meetings, usually every 2 weeks, which features speakers, tours of local business, cultural activities, discussions and visits to other clubs.

**XII. YOUTH RED CROSS**

The youth red cross is the most important constituent of its mother organization, Indian Red Cross. It is a group movement organized at the initial stages for students between 18 and 25 years of age within the colleges. A qualified lecturer is recognized as the leader and he is called the Programme Officer under his guidance, the students are trained and encouraged to manage the affairs of the group, electing their own office bearers.

**XIII. COUNSELLING CELL**

Counselling centre provides support and guidance to students who are experiencing moderate to severe mental stress.

**XIV COACHING CLASSES:**

Our College is conducting the coaching classes for TNPSC Group-I, II & IV Examinations, Bank Exams, TRB & TET for the welfare of the students.

**LIBRARY RULES**

1. Strict silence must be preserved in and around the library.

4. All books must be returned to the library five days before the end of each semester
5. Students are advised to return the books on or before the due date, failing which, fine will be collected at the rate of Rs.5/- per day.
6. The librarian has the right to call back any book lent to the student at any time before the due date of return.
7. No one is allowed to sublend the books taken out by her to others.
8. Books have to be treated and handled with great care.
9. In the event of loss off or damage to a book the person responsible shall either pay its cost or replace it by a book within a week.
10. If the library card is lost, the student is advised to inform the librarian immediately without fail.
11. Students are asked to return the book personally to the Librarian; under no circumstances should the card be transferred to another person.
12. Students are not permitted to bring their personal belongings inside the library.
13. Dictionaries and reference books will not be issued on loan.
14. Students must surrender the library cards at the time of leaving the college.


